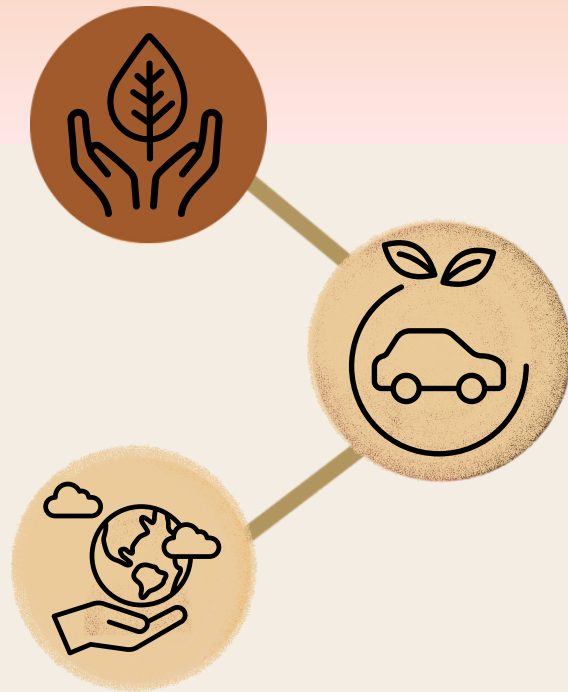
About the Role
