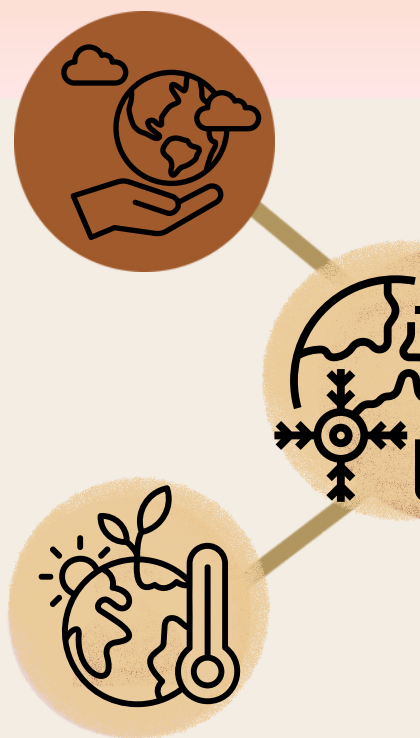

About the Role

We are seeking a committed Specialist – Climate Action to lead district-level initiatives for restoring degraded landscapes while strengthening local capacities, fostering convergence across government schemes, and promoting restoration-linked livelihoods. This role is central to advancing TRI's mission of integrating climate-responsive solutions into rural development systems and building resilience for people, nature, and the climate.

Responsibilities

- Develop and implement district-level landscape restoration action plans based on ecological, social, and livelihood priorities, coordinating with local government departments like Panchayati Raj, Forest, Agriculture, and Rural Development to ensure convergence of schemes, while facilitating participatory planning processes with communities, Self-Help Groups (SHGs), local administration, PRIs, and local institutions.
- Strengthen the capabilities of community institutions, NGOs, and frontline staff to lead landscape restoration efforts through trainings and workshops on restoration practices, water-soil management, biodiversity regeneration, and monitoring.



- Align district-level activities with national/state flagship programs like MGNREGA, CAMPA, Jal Jeevan Mission, and Watershed Development, and prepare district convergence frameworks with cross-departmental commitment.
- Develop progress reports and monitoring frameworks on restoration outcomes (soil, water, biodiversity, livelihoods) and document success stories and lessons learned for state and national knowledge-sharing.
- Promote landscape-based enterprises like eco-tourism, non-timber forest produce, and agroforestry value chains, and develop market linkages for restoration-driven livelihoods.
- Any other responsibilities

Knowledge and Skills

- Strong understanding of government structures and processes, with the ability to facilitate timely approvals and communications
- Experience in managing and delivering mitigation and restoration projects
- Capability to build and maintain networks across institutions and organizations, particularly in Central India
- Multi-lingual with experience working in diverse cultural contexts
- Sound knowledge of carbon sequestration science and carbon markets

Qualifications & Experiences

- Post-graduate degree in a field related to forestry, natural resource management, ecology or another related field of study with 3-5 years of experience relevant to this position
- Experience with the management of large projects in the conservation/forestry/natural resource management sector
- Experience understanding of topics related to forests, conservation and people
- Experience understanding of the principles and practice of integrated landscape approaches to restoration (i.e., both within and outside forests)
- Good communication skills, both verbal and writing skills is required
