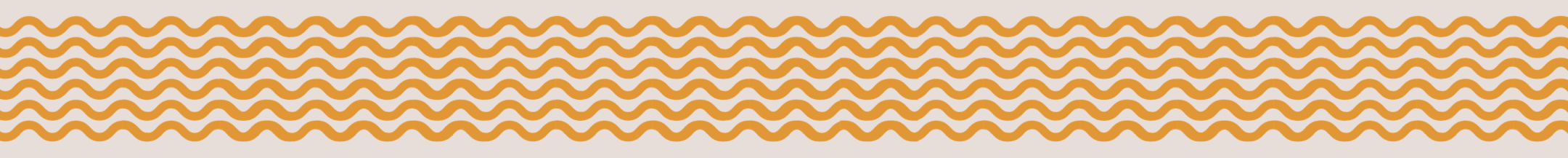

What Will You Do?

- Build the capacity of ASHAs, ANMs, AWWs, and other frontline health workers
- Mobilize SHGs, VOs, VHSNCs, and PRI institutions to improve screening uptake and treatment adherence
- Support community awareness and behaviour change initiatives on NCD prevention and early detection
- Monitor programme performance, screening coverage, referrals, and follow-ups
- Coordinate with NHM, SRLM, and block-level stakeholders to strengthen service delivery and referral systems
- Document best practices and support the adoption of digital tracking and feedback mechanisms.

Who Are We Looking For?

- Postgraduate degree in Public Health, Social Sciences, Management, or a related discipline.
