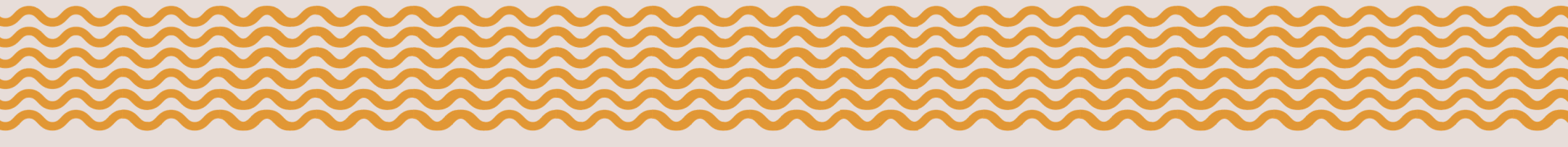

What Will You Do?

- Lead district and block-level screening programmes for NCDs and priority cancers
- Strengthen referral pathways and ensure effective use of digital tracking systems
- Coordinate with government departments, health facilities, and partner organizations
- Train and mentor frontline health workers (ASHAs, ANMs, CHOs)
- Monitor programme quality, track performance, and prepare regular reports
- Manage screening camp operations, logistics, and compliance requirements
- Drive community awareness and mobilization to improve screening uptake and timely care
